Bangladesh Consulate General Toronto celebrates 50th Victory Day

Bangladesh Consulate General in Toronto celebrated the 50th Glorious Victory Day on 16 December 2020 with due fervour and solemnity. Consulate officials have organized the Victory Day celebrations maintaining social distance amid Covid-19 lock-down in Toronto.

Celebration of the day began with hoisting Bangladesh National Flag in the morning. The afternoon programme started with paying homage to the martyrs of the War of Liberation and Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman. Video messages of the Hon'ble President and the Hon'ble Prime Minister on occasion of Victory Day were screened.
