



- The government targets an astounding USD 5 billion export and promises to create employment for around 500,000 people by 2025.
- The IT and ITES industry of Bangladesh has grown by 40% annually since 2010.
- The sector, comprising of around 4,500+ companies, has been declared as a thrust sector by the Government to meet its goal of being a digital economy by 2021 and a knowledge-based economy by 2041.
- The sector's prospect is being driven by a young workforce interested in freelancing and IT, lower cost for human resources, government incentives including IT-based training and increasing establishment of IT Parks.





Bangladesh is among the Top 5 Fastest Growing Economy




