Bangladesh Consulate General in Toronto celebrated the historic 7th March speech of the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman with due honour and respect. The first part of the program began by hoisting national flag at Bangladesh House, and the second part at the Consulate General comprised offering flower wreath before the portrait of the Father of the Nation, reading out the messages of the Hon'ble President and Hon'ble Prime Minister, screening documentary on the 7 March speech, screening the full video speech of the Father of the Nation and recitation of poems.
